



The Dasher Doggy Doll is a pattern designed for beginners or sewers who prefer hand sewing over machine stitching. The pattern can be made with a variety of different materials starting from plush to knit fabrics.

FINISHED SIZE: 15" HEIGHT (APPROX)



It is recommended making the doll with plush fabric or felt because the children love the feel of these materials. Due to the relatively small size of the doll, it is a quick project even when made without a sewing machine.

The stretched ears give a unique cuteness to the Dasher Doggy compared to other doll patterns and the addition of embroidery thread to the nose of the muzzle will add to the adorable little project. Get started on a memorable gift for your special person with the Dasher Doggy Doll!

Material List

- 44" wide plush or faux fur or fleece or knit fabric or terrycloth or velvet or felt (1/4) Yard for Teddy body
- 1 Piece of 8" x 12" felt
- Felt scrap for eyes
- 1 Color of embroidery thread
- Fiberfill

- Ruler, Scissors, Chalk pencil, Pencil, Sewing machine, Pins, Needle, Shape tool
